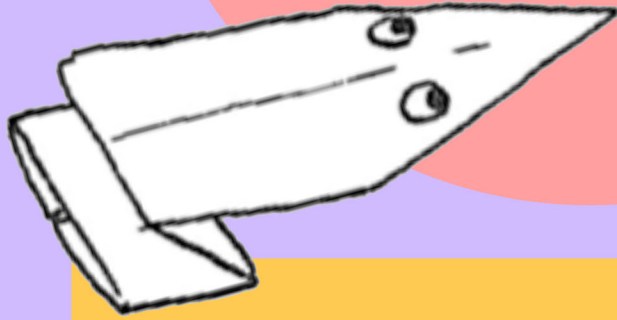
Create at Home

Materials you will need:

A sheet of paper

Scissors

Colouring Pencils or felt pens



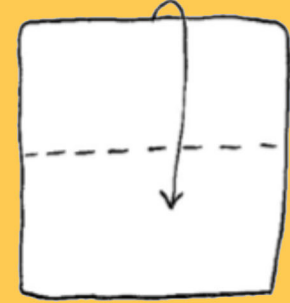
You will need a square piece of paper to fold a frog or a fox. This is how to make a piece of paper square:

- 1) Fold the top left hand corner down to meet the right edge of the paper so that you have a triangle on top of a rectangle.
- 2) Cut the excess rectangle away and unfold the triangle so that you have a square.

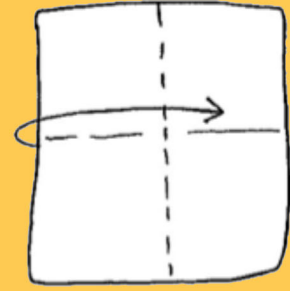
Fold a Frog

How to make an Origami Frog:

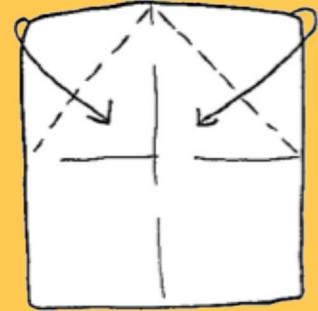
1) Fold your paper in half to create a crease. Then unfold.



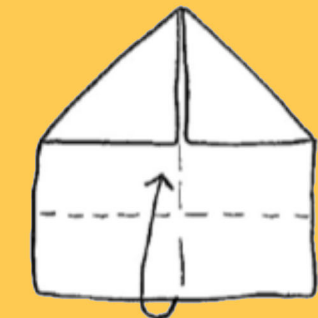
2) Fold in half the other way, then unfold to create a crease.



3) Fold the top corners in to the centre.

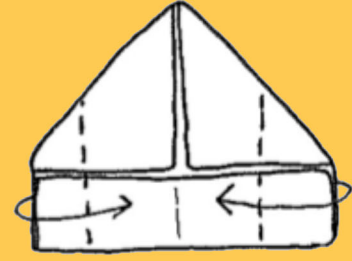


4) Fold the bottom half into the centre.

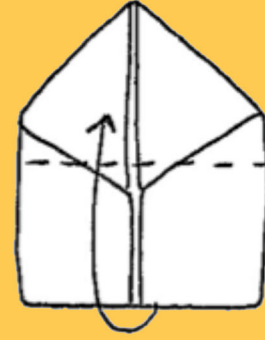


Fold a Frog

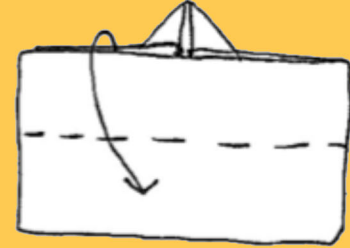
5) Now fold the bottom sides into the centre.



6) Fold in half towards the point.



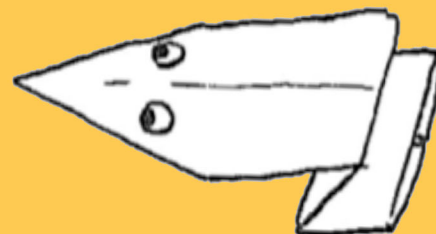
7) Fold the bottom half into half again.



8) The bottom half should look like this.



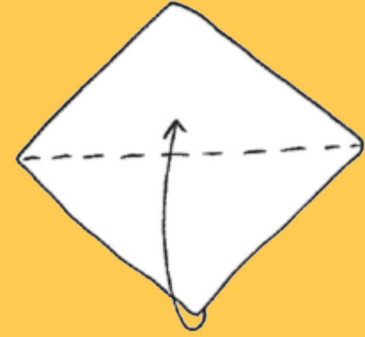
9) You can now complete your frog by drawing eyes or adding other features.



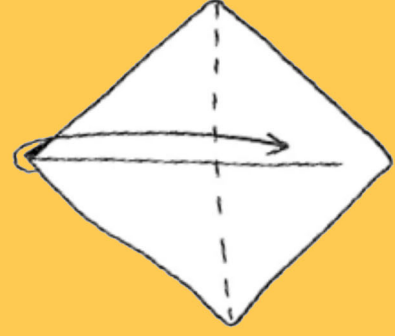
Fold a Fox

How to make an Origami Fox:

1) Fold your paper in half to create a crease and then unfold.



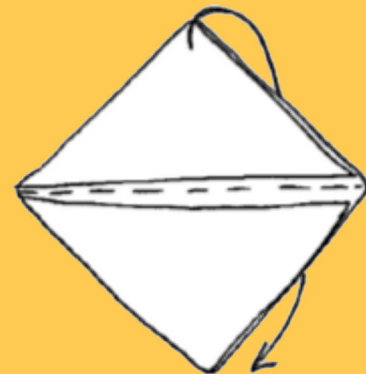
2) Then fold in half the other way.



3) Fold the corners up to the centre crease.



4) Now fold in half.

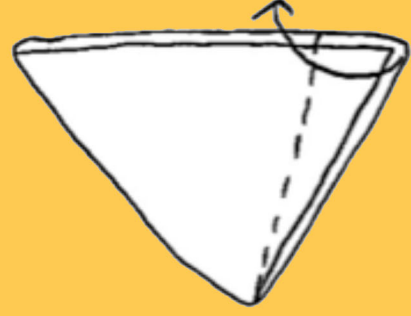

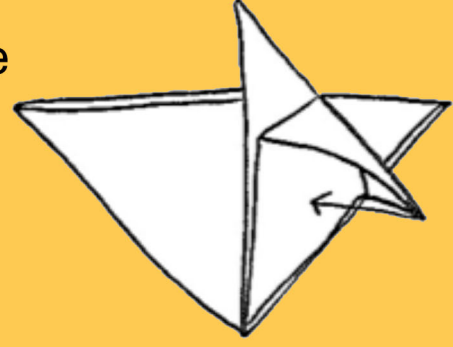

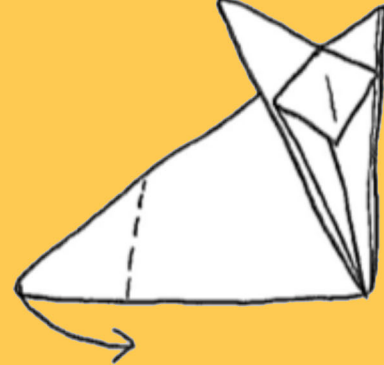
5) Open the dotted part and flatten



6) Fold down the middle corner, like shown below.



7) Now fold the tail in.



8) You can now draw eyes, a nose and add other features.
