A share of your estate

You may wish to leave Firstsite all or part of what is left of your estate after other gifts and debts have been paid. This type of gift (known as a residuary bequest) has the advantage that it will not be eroded in value by inflation over the years.



A cash gift

You may wish to leave us a stated sum of money.
With this kind of gift (known as a pecuniary bequest), it is important to remember that the value of money changes over the years, and you may need to alter your Will periodically to keep up with inflation.



A property

By leaving a property to Firstsite you can give support to thousands of children. For example, a property worth £350,000 could pay to run our Holiday Fun programme for 10 years, providing thousands of free meals and creative activities to children and families.

Telephone: Farewill also provides a telephone service. You can speak to a Will specialist on the phone who will guide you through the process. Call now on: **0203 318 4279**.





Free exhibitions

Suggested wording

Here is some suggesting wording you could use when writing your Will. Please note that the information provided below is suggested and does not constitute legal advice. We recommend always seeking your own legal advice when writing your will.

Residuary Gift

I give all the rest of my estate both real and personal to my Executors on trust to sell and convert the same into money and after payment of all my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses to hold the net proceeds of sale and the net rents and profits until sale upon trust to pay them to Firstsite (Registered Charity Number 1031800) of Lewis Gardens, High Street, Colchester, Essex CO1 1JH, and I declare that the receipt in writing of the treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of that charity shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executors. There are tax implications to leaving your residuary estate to charity and non-charity beneficiaries. We recommend seeking professional advice if this is the case.

Pecuniary Gift

I give to Firstsite (Registered Charity Number 1031800) Lewis Gardens, High Street, Colchester, Essex C01 1JH, the sum of £X for its general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of its Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executors.



Terms and conditions

Summary of free Will writing service

Firstsite has partnered with two Will writing services: Farewill Ltd (online and telephone Wills) and the National Free Wills Network (solicitor based Wills).

Farewill and the National Free Wills Network have control of and are responsible for preparing your Will, not Firstsite. Firstsite recommends that you carry out your own independent research on the providers which we are partnered with, and other Will writers, and only choose the services of the providers if you are satisfied with their quality of service.

There is no obligation to include a gift in your Will to Firstsite to use either free Will writing service.

Farewill and the National Free Wills Network will be acting only in your interests and on your instructions. You will not be able to get a free Will from either Farewill or the National Free Wills Network unless you agree to their terms and conditions. Firstsite reserves the right to pause or withdraw the free Will writing services.

Online Wills

- Farewill online Will writing service is only available in England and Wales.

Beth, Age 24

I experienced challenges with trying to find creative spaces. It's hard to find creative spaces especially if you are in the young adult, early 20s bracket. I think there should be more YAKs everywhere because if your main hobbies are creative or artistic it can sometimes be isolating when there are limited opportunities.

I like being able to talk to people while doing projects I enjoy at the same time. I also like how YAK exposes you to more creative opportunities i.e. the youth climate summit.

YAK has helped me to grow a lot. I'm more confident and more knowledgeable about how to use different art materials. It mademe consider myself to be an artist more than before. I have been a member of YAK for a long time, and it has given me lots of positive experiences.

Art can have a big impact on people's lives whether for the audience or for the person making, as a hobby or a career.



Moth, Age 18

I enjoy having a regular artistic group to interact with and be creative at. I loved the first session I joined where we went on a foraging walk around Highwoods and collected clay from the stream.

YAK helped me be more comfortable trying new art forms and being bad at them because there's no judgement and no pressure to be good at anything.



I had my animation shown in the Lunar Lullabies exhibition. I loved seeing my work be part of a group exhibition that was on over the whole summer. It was nice to show work in a professional environment as it felt like I could take myself seriously as an artist.

YAK introduced me to new art forms and subjects like foraging for natural pigments and art in folklore that have helped me work out how to use my creative skills in a historical and archaeological career.

Jessie, Age 22

When looking for other opportunities around Colchester on return from uni, it was challenging to find entry-level/youth opportunities. I felt worried if returning would limit my creative progress due to this. YAK gives a free space to create. Weekly and routine time creates stability in the week for creativity and to meet like-minded people your age or in similar stages of artistic journeys.

Taking part in exhibitions at Firstsite was very exciting. I had fun creating ideas for exhibition themes and exhibited at the Minories too. It gave me confidence in art and understanding of processes in submitting artwork. It made me think about jobs in gallery spaces, gave understanding about marketing, workshop facilitators and curating. My exhibition work was sold in the shop – very cool! It was exciting to see my work in different contexts.
